

Billings Petroleum Club

It's called Big Sky Country for a reason.

Astounding views of Billings, Montana and the Beartooth Mountains, await at the Billings Petroleum Club, located at the top of the Hilton Doubletree Hotel in Billings, Montana. The Billings Petroleum Club (BPC) has been accommodating members and their guests since 1954. The idea for the club began four years earlier with a landman from Continental Oil Company, H.F. "Tax" King. His proposal for a private club became a reality when the BPC opened in a vacant building next to the city's Stockman Bar and Café. In the beginning, the Club thrived during a growth period of the oil and gas industry, but by the end of that decade, activity slowed, and oil companies began moving out of Billings. Efforts to save the BPC were great – including a pledge by roughly 50 members who volunteered to prepay their dues for the life of a 15-year lease in a new building. Some 20 years later, a local developer offered to relocate the club to the 22nd floor of his new hotel, where it remains today.

The club continued to do well until the early 2000s, when membership began to drop. To try and broaden its appeal to those outside the oil industry, the club changed its name to the Billings Professional Club. A January 2003 deadline was set for the club to create a survival plan or close permanently. Once again, several members came forward to help and a new program for sponsor advertising was created, saving the club from extinction. Shortly thereafter, a survey of members, happy that their club had been saved, showed that most preferred to go back to the name Billings Petroleum Club, and so it was restored.

Having completed a major renovation just three years ago, the Billings Petroleum Club is an impressive space, at the top of one of the tallest free-standing brick buildings in the U.S. Recently, its General Manager and Chef, Jeremy Engebretson, was nominated for the prestigious James Beard award, which recognizes excellence in culinary professionals. Menus feature classic steak house choices with a new-world approach, including locally sourced filet mignon, rib eye, or roasted duck, each served with a variety of house-made sauces and sides. Diners can enjoy daily specials and menus that change every few weeks offering guests something new each time they visit. The varied menu provides several choices for weddings, birthdays, family reunions, or any other special gathering you can imagine. It's also the perfect setting for that important business meeting, seminar, or stakeholder's dinner. The BPC prides itself on excellent service, making members and their guests feel relaxed and welcomed as soon as they enter the door.
