Before becoming the President & CEO, Ms. Turvey served as Chairwoman of the Board of Directors from 2011-2015. Soon after, she and her team turned Leisnoi around, from financial hardship and distress to a multi-million dollar and growing company. Under Ms. Turvey's leadership, Leisnoi has paid annual shareholder dividends, found a Shareholder Settlement Trust, and built a federal contracting sector.

Ms. Turvey earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana and a Juris Doctorate from the University of Colorado at Boulder. She is currently on track to earn her Certificate of Professional Development from The Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania. Prior to joining Leisnoi, Ms. Turvey was the Vice-President of Legal Affairs & General Counsel for Ahtna, Inc. and served as the Sr. Vice-President of Corporate Affairs for Afognak Native Corporation.

She has served on multiple boards including Alaska Native Village Corporation Association (ANVCA) Board of Directors and on the Spaceport Advisory Group for Alaska Aerospace. She recently completed 4 years of service as a co-chair of the Alaska Bar Association Alaska Native Law section and has also served on the Board of Directors for Koniag, Inc. As if that's not enough, Ms. Turvey spent last summer volunteering for her children's sports' booster clubs and co-lead a successful fundraising event for a friend who's 2-year old had been diagnosed with childhood kidney cancer.

Steve holds Bachelor of Science (1985) and Master of Science (1988) degrees in Petroleum Engineering from Louisiana Tech University. He began his professional

career with ARCO in 1988 and has extensive experience in drilling, completion, and intervention assignments in Alaska, onshore United States (Rockies, Permian Basin, Mid-continent, East Texas, and South Louisiana), Gulf of Mexico Deepwater, Algeria, Russia (Sakhalin) and North Sea (UK Sector).


