We asked members to share their questions with us about the Club. Here are a few queries we received last month and the answers to them.



How do I log onto the website?

This is the number one question we get from members, so if you've tried to use the website but can't, you're not alone. Our website is www.petroclub.net. To log on, your user name is your member number and your password is your last name all lower case (unless you've set your own password after you initially logged on).

We encourage members to use the website for making reservations. Simply go to the Quick Links box on the left side of the page, click on 'Make a Dining Reservation' and click on the available day and time you want. Once the reservation is made, you should get an email confirmation. If you do not, please go to your profile page and make sure we have your correct email address on file.

The website is also a great place to learn about upcoming events. To see the calendar, go to the Social tab and use the drop down to click on Club Calendar. From there, you can click on the event you want and make a reservation to attend.

CONUNDRUM SPARKLING

Melon and citrus on the nose, crisp freshly cut fruit on the palate with warm notes of peach and lemon are layered in this minerally, bright wine with a long, wonderful finish.

JUSTIN ROSE 2017

Clear pink with an apple, peach, and strawberry aroma, this wine is made entirely of Cabernet Sauvignon, the flagship grape variety of Justin. Fruity at first, this delicate rose exhibits herbal flavors as well.

FERRARI CARANO FUME BLANC

Delicious aromas and tastes of pink grapefruit, lemongrass, peach, pear, melon and orange blossom with a touch of minerality make this wine inviting at first sip. Its crisp, fresh flavor with a subtle oak character, will have you coming back for more.

SEA SUN CALIFORNIA CHARDONNAY 2016

Grilled mango, soft butterscotch, juicy apple and ripened apricot greet your nose, while hints of fresh sea air and a trace of smokiness add intriguing layers to this lovely, pale wine. Round and creamy on the palate, the wine finishes with toast, cinnamon and a kick of lemon.

FERRARI - MERLOT

Beautifully balanced with a medium body, this velvety wine exhibits a nose of plum, chocolate spice, dark berries, coffee and cedar. A fleshy mouthfeel is followed by flavors of red fruit, ripe tannins and a long, elegant finish.

BONANZA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Toasty oak and flavors of berries mix with vanilla in this ruby-red wine. Scents of currants, dried roses and freshly tilled soil fill the nose and a lengthy finish trails off in the mouth with tastes of unsweetened chocolate and cassis.

PHELPS CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Your senses will be filled with berry and violet with notes of graphite and cloves followed by layers of currant jam, roasted coffee, tobacco, fig and vanilla. This is a full-bodied wine with supple tannins and a lengthy finish.

MER SOLEIL PINOT NOIR

It's named after two forces of nature – sea and sun – a mark of California's cool, coastal region where the wine is produced. Dark plum in color with scents of ripe berries, cocoa and toasted wood, this wine has a lush feel with flavors of cherry, cola and anise, ending in a lasting freshness.

WESTMOUNT PINOT GRIS

White flowers, honeysuckle, pear and lemon will brighten your mood at first sip of this refreshing Pinot Gris. Crisp, tropical fruit notes integrate with exotic spices and minerals for a lingering finish.

LES TOURELLES PREMIER CRU

This fresh Chardonnay reveals aromas of apple, almond, fern and citrus. A lively, rich palate with spicy undertones, the wine leaves a long, flavorful aftertaste with a distinctive minerality. Ready to taste?
